Professor Barbara Jack

Director, Evidence-Based Practice Research Centre, Edge Hill University

Barbara Jack completed her nurse training and held various clinical posts in the NHS until she moved into nurse education joining Edge Hill University in 1992. Barbara undertook a part time PhD at the University of Manchester followed by a secondment to the Marie Curie Palliative Care Institute, University of Liverpool, to undertake research in palliative care, where she now remains as an Honorary Fellow, collaborating on various projects.

Barbara was awarded a Professorial chair in 2006 and is currently the Faculty of Health & Social Care, Head of Research as well as Director of the Evidence Based Research Centre.

In 2006 Barbara established links with Hospice Africa Uganda and in 2010 was made a Visiting Professor. Barbara is editorial board member of Nurse Researcher and chair of the Palliative Care Research Society.
